

## Quelques précisions sur les niveaux de WebSphere MQ 5.3

---

Le produit WebSphere MQ 5.3 a été livré suivant les plates-formes en deux phases, GA1 et GA2 :

- GA 1 = Juin 2002 : Windows NT, Windows 2000, Solaris, HP-UX
- GA 2 = Octobre 2002 : Windows XP, iSeries (AS/400), Linux (Intel & zSeries)

De plus, en Octobre 2002, les produits livrés en Juin ont fait l'objet d'une nouvelle livraison incluant des correctifs de la CSD1

Il y a eu un certain nombre de débats sur des listes techniques et ailleurs pour savoir quelle était la version courante de WebSphere MQ. Quelques imprécisions sur des sites et documents IBM ont d'ailleurs alimentés ces débats.

La situation est maintenant simple :

- La GA1, livrée en Juin 2002, est la **version 5.3**
- La GA2, livrée en Octobre 2002, est la **version 5.3.0.1**
- Il n'y a pas de version 5.3.1
- L'application de la CSD 1 sur une version 5.3 permettra de passer à la 5.3.0.1

Cette numérotation s'applique aussi aux clients MQ.

En annexe, ci-joint le mail en provenance de Paul Clarke, d'IBM Rochester, qui a permis d'éclairer nos lanternes !

*Hi all,*

*For those of you still a little confused about the 5.3 GA1 and GA2 releases here's a note I got from our Release Planner prompted by the questions raised on this list. The Windows, AIX, Solaris and HP-UX WebSphere MQ V5.3 products were first released in June 2002. If you run the mqver command they will display:  
Name: WebSphere MQ  
Version: 530  
CMVC level: p000-L020617  
BuildType: IKAP - (Production)*

*Recently we released the iSeries, Linux on Intel and Linux on zSeries products and added support for windows-XP to the windows product. At the same time we updated the AIX , Solaris and HP-UX products to include fixes found during the testing of the iSeries and Linux products. If you are entitled to down load these products from our electronic software download site you will get the latest level. If you are a passport advantage customer and received the June CD version you should get the October CDs automatically. mqver will report:*

CMVC level: p000-L021011  
BuildType: IKAP - (Production)

We hope to make available a CSD to update the June release to the October release. When this is installed mqver will report:

Name: WebSphere MQ  
Version: 530  
CMVC level: p000-L021011  
BuildType: IKAP - (Production)

Note that you can use the level information to determine which level of product you have installed. The CMVC level includes the build date as Lyymmdd yy is year, mm month and dd day.

The October release is a service upgrade to the June release, it is not a new version. We have not released a new product called V5.3.1, although there may have been some confusion on the naming on our electronic software download site which should now have been corrected.

Hope this helps, our collective apologies for any confusion caused,
